#### **MARRIAGE**

JOHN OF THE CROSS was born in 1542 at Fontiveros in Spain. He entered the Carmelite Community and was ordained a priest in 1567. Renowned for his wisdom and sanctity, he died at Ubeda in 1591. His writings are not only classics of spirituality, but also of Spanish literature. His best known books are The Ascent of Mount Carmel, The Dark Night of the Soul, and The Living Flame of Love.

#### PLEASE PRAY FOR ALL OF THE SICK

Perhaps you've been wondering about the meaning of the Jesse tree that we put together each year. Many of us are familiar with the concept of a family tree- a way of showing our grandparents and great grandparents and their families. In many churches you will see the same idea used in the stained glass or a carving to show the connection between the figures of the Scriptures, and before many people could read, these were a teaching tool for showing the connection between the figures of the Hebrew Scriptures and Jesus himself. Jesse trees were the storybooks of the time. From this it became clear that the birth of Jesus was not an isolated event, but the completion of the story- the flowering of the tree, planted by God so long before. The link to King David was clear and so Jesus could be seen as a real historical person. Today there are many versions of the Jesse tree, using many different symbols to represent the various figures and events of Hebrew history that led to the birth of Jesus. Let us enjoy our own Jesse tree and listen carefully to the meaning of each symbol we have chosen.
