MARRIAGE

JOHN OF THE CROSS was born in 1542 at Fontiveros in Spain. He entered the Carmelite Community and was ordained a priest in 1567. Renowned for his wisdom and sanctity, he died at Ubeda in 1591. His writings are not only classics of spirituality, but also of Spanish literature. His best known books are The Ascent of Mount Carmel, The Dark Night of the Soul, and The Living Flame of Love.

SEPTEMBER 1: ANNUAL WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE CARE OF CREATION



1. The earth cries out ...

As an integral ecology emphasizes, human beings are deeply connected with all of creation. When we mistreat nature, we also mistreat human beings. Let us hear "*both the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor"* (*Laudato Si'*, 49), and do our best to ensure an appropriate and timely response.

2. ... for we have sinned

During this Jubilee Year, let us learn to implore God's mercy for those sins against creation that we have not hitherto acknowledged and confessed.

3. Examination of conscience and repentance After a serious examination of conscience and moved by sincere repentance, we can confess our sins against the Creator, against creation, and against our brothers and sisters. We confess them because we are penitent and desire to change.

4. Changing course

A single question can keep our eyes fixed on the goal: "What kind of world do we want to leave to those who come after us, to children who are now growing up?"

5. A new work of mercy

The Christian life involves the practice of the traditional seven corporal and seven spiritual works of mercy.[10] But if we look at the works of mercy as a whole, we see that the object of mercy is human life itself and everything it embraces."[11]
