4 ASPECTS OF THE ASCENSION MISSION

So, at Easter, we emphasize the resurrection, the passing of Jesus through death to life. Today, on the feast of the Ascension, we remember more the "exaltation" of Jesus, as he is raised up to share equal glory with His Father.



Ascension

There are four aspects to the mission which Jesus gives:

- a. There is the duty of the Christian community to evangelize, that is, to communicate the life vision that is contained in the Christian Testament and especially the Gospel. It must be stressed that this is not simply the responsibility of the clergy or of religious men and women. It is the duty of every single Christian, arising from the very nature of being a disciple. The world is still under the influence of a Europe which was once totally Christian and where evangelization was understood as the clergy keeping a passive laity "in the state of grace". We no longer have such a world not even in Europe.
- b. The church has the task of healing. The Christian is not simply concerned with the "soul". The whole person needs to experience the effects of salvation in spirit, mind, feelings, body, and in the surrounding environment. Jesus himself spent a lot of time healing the sick. It was often linked with the healing of the soul and of the heart and the reconciliation of the sinner. The disharmony which sin is can have very visible effects on the feelings and on the body. It is not enough simply to remove the sin (by going to confession) nor is it enough simply to try to heal the body (by going to hospital). Healing involves the whole person. That, as Christians, we are all called to do.
- c. Jesus promises that the Spirit will give power to his disciples. This is not to be political or economic power. Again it is not a power simply vested in the hierarchy. It is the power, shared by all, that comes from a vibrant vision of what life should be.

4 Ways to Respond to the Gift of Grace

1. Ask for what you need.

In the prayer Jesus taught us, we ask for daily bread, forgiveness, and guidance on the way. You might ask for the grace to deal better with a difficult person at work. Or pray for the grace to be kinder when your child asks "why" for the umpteenth time. Don't be afraid to ask.

2. Ask with an open mind.

Be willing to let go of your own agenda and say yes to the grace God offers. Don't hand God your game plan and say, "Here are my ideas, and I'm counting on you to do your part." Remember, "Thy (meaning God's) will be done."

3. Watch for the ways God responds.

Grace often arrives in surprising ways. Through prayer and being aware, you can learn to recognize God at work in your life. One of the surest signs of God's grace: a feeling of gratitude and a desire to give to others.

4. Pass it on!

When we love one another, we pass on God's life to others. Having been blessed, we can bless others in our family, at work, in our community. Having been forgiven, we can forgive others. Having been strengthened, we can share our strength. Grace is not meant to be hoarded and stored. It's meant to touch the lives of others.

When you move through your day buoyed by God's grace, it can spill over into the lives of your spouse, your child, all those in whose lives you participate. Grace is truly the gift that keeps giving. (Loyola Press, A Jesuit Ministry)
