## 4th Sunday of Lent

1st Reading: 1 Samuel 16.1b, 6-7, 10-13 2nd Reading: Ephesians 5:8-14 Gospel: John 9:1-41 *Jesus Heals a Blind Man* 

## True Recovery of Sight

In today's Gospel, we encounter Jesus healing a man who was born blind. In all of the Bible, this is the only healing of a man blind since birth, whereas other healings were of temporary blindness. The uniqueness of this great mystery offers us the ability to richly reflect on what it means to be good stewards of Christ.

Firstly, while the man was healed of his physical sight, the more remarkable miracle was his ability to grasp Jesus' true identity. When Jesus reveals to him that He is the Son of Man, the blind man boldly responds, "Lord, I



believe." The blind man did not come to this realization on his own, but it was the Lord's working in his life that led him to this chance of heart.

So too, in all of us, it is the **Lord and His grace** that brings about our interior conversion. We must **never** fall into the temptation that our faith and charity is the result of our own strength or abilities. After the blind man's encounter, it says "he worshipped Him." As good stewards, we should seek to imitate his example, falling down in thanks-giving and adoration for all of the grace and gifts the Lord has poured into our lives. Let us take a moment today to praise God most especially for the gifts of our Catholic faith and the Church.

With all the things happening, persevere in faith. Pray together with your family, read the scripture, share faith stories, sing Praise and Worship songs together.


