PAPAL FLAG



The flag of Vatican City (Papal Flag) has been displayed in the sanctuary alongside the Canada flag this month. The Papal Flag has two vertical bands:

gold or yellow and white. The white band has the coat of arms of Vatican City which consists of the papal tiara and two crossed keys, silver and gold, representing the keys of St. Peter, the *Keys of Heaven* (Matthew 16:19). The gold key represents spiritual power, the silver key represents worldly power. A red cord connects the keys.

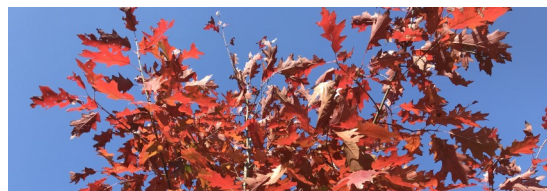

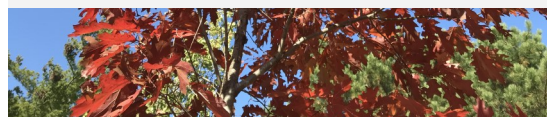
