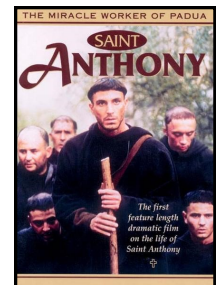

# DEACON JOHN CANNON

January 8, 1947—February 4, 2021

Deacon John Cannon died peacefully at his home, surrounded by the love of his family, on February 4, 2021. He is predeceased by his father, William Cannon, and his mother, Anastasia Catramadou. John will be sorely missed by his wife and best friend, Susan (née McGregor), his loving children Heather (Stan) and Glen (Sarah), his beloved grandchildren Taryn, Caitlyn, and Griffin, his adoring sister Rosemary (Carmine) as well as a multitude of extended family and parishioners.



John lived a full life - he was a successful businessman, world traveler, and scuba diver. Ordained to the Diaconate in 2004, he served as a Deacon at St. John of the Cross Carmelite Church in Meadowvale for 12 years. His homilies were peppered with humorous stories that fostered connections with parishioners of all ages. John is a compassionate human being, passionate about his ministry, and a great homilist.

John and Susan volunteer in ministry through the Spiritual Care Department of Trillium Health Partners. John regularly visits men and women of all faiths who require kidney dialysis and at multiple hospital locations he provides a caring and listening presence to those he serves.

When not doing his ministries, John was rarely seen without a tool in his hand. He was a skilled engineer who was willing to help anyone fix anything. He built many construction projects like decks, gazebos, treehouses, and zip lines that will continue to be enjoyed by family and friends for years to come. John loved spending quality time with his grandchildren at the cottage going fishing, roasting marshmallows, and exploring the lake on his motor boat.

John will be cremated and interred at St. Mary's Cemetery in Chandos Township. A celebration of John's life will be held when all those who loved him can gather safely. In lieu of flowers, please send donations to the Carlo Fidani Peel Regional Cancer Centre, where John received stellar care from everyone, especially the doctors and nurses.

We will miss a wonderful Deacon, a parish team member, and a good friend. Our prayers and sympathies to Susan and the Cannon Family.
