These sessions are offered to all who feel ready to take this step in their journey of grief.

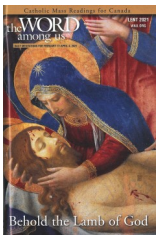

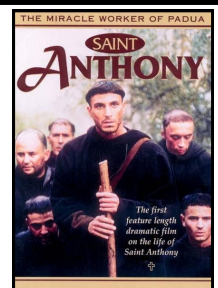
