 I trust in You. Amen.

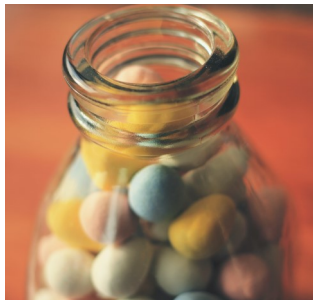

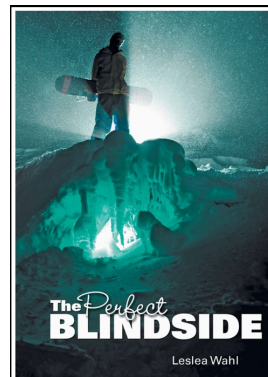
**FAMILY ACTIVITY FOR

Taking turns, offer a Thank you to God. The person who just offered a thank you, drops a pebble into the jar. For example, a person may say, "Thank you for our health," then that person drops a pebble into the jar. Keep going until all the Thank Yous have been said. Then together, pray the Glory be to the Father .... Make the sign of the cross.
