What is The Liturgy of the Hours? - The Liturgy of the Hours (also called the Divine Office or Breviary) is the official prayer of the Church consisting of psalms, readings, and hymns that are recited at stated hours of the day and sanctifying the day with prayer. The two most important or hinge Hours are Morning and Evening Prayer.

When do we virtually gather to pray the Liturgy of the Hours? - We will gather to pray on Thursday evenings at 7pm during the church lockdown. Zoom registration will be listed in the weekly bulletin.

How do we pray the Liturgy of the Hours? - In line with tradition, participants take turns reciting the verses which will be shared screen. By taking turns, we can both add our voices to the prayers and train our hearts to listen.

How long will the Liturgy be? - The Liturgy of the Hours usually takes about 15 minutes. We may pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy before the Liturgy of the Hours.
