you are interested in volunteering, please leave your name, phone number, and email address at the church office.





DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Jesus, I Trust in You!

DIVINE MERCY QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q. Can I attend the Vigil Mass on Saturday and receive the graces of Divine Mercy Sunday?

A. Yes, the Vigil Mass fulfills the Sunday obligation of the Feast of Divine Mercy, so the extraordinary graces are available when you receive Holy Communion in a state of grace at the Saturday Vigil Mass.

Q. How can I receive extraordinary graces on Divine Mercy Sunday?

A. In order to receive the extraordinary graces, you should prepare by making a good confession, so that you can receive Holy Communion in a state of grace on Divine Mercy Sunday. In addition, Our Lord asked St. Faustina to be sure to perform acts of mercy, and to come to Him in Holy Communion with great trust in His mercy.

Q. Why is the beginning of the Chaplet optional?

A. The Chaplet, as dictated to St. Faustina by our Lord, begins with the Our Father, the Hail Mary, and the Apostles Creed. The prayer which begins, You expired, Jesus (Diary 1319), may be used as an introductory prayer to the Chaplet.

Q. When should I go to confession in order to receive the extraordinary graces?

A. You do not have to go to confession on Mercy Sunday itself. We know from her Diary that St. Faustina made her confession in preparation for Mercy Sunday on the day before (Diary 1072). In fact, all of Lent should be a preparation to make a good confession to receive Holy Communion worthily on Easter Sunday and Divine Mercy Sunday. Sin is the only obstacle to our fervent reception of Holy Communion, and our sins can be wiped away by the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The important thing is to receive Holy Communion on these great feast days in a state of grace, and with great trust in God's mercy. Don't wait until the last moment, take advantage of the extra confession time that is made available during Lent.

INCOME TAX PREPARATION For Eligible Individuals

Free income tax preparation for low income individuals is offered by the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP), coordinated by the Canada Revenue Agency.

Contact the parish office to check eligibility and to book an appointment on Saturdays from 9 AM to 12:00 PM, during the months of March and April.

Due to the current restrictions, all tax preparation will be completed by way of **telephone interview** with the approval of the taxpayer.

To qualify for the CVITP program, the income requirements (Approx.) are as follows:

\$35,000 for a single person who has no dependents

- \$45,000 for a single parent and 1 child plus \$2,500 per additional dependent
- \$45,000 for a couple plus \$2,500 per dependent

The clinic does not complete tax returns for individuals with rental income, capital gains, self-employment / business income or returns for deceased individuals.

Interest income must be below \$1,000.

Divine Mercy Sunday

Hi guys! As we continue to celebrate Easter, do you know that the Sunday after Easter Sunday is designated as the Divine Mercy Sunday? Yes, it is!

You see, sometime in the 1930's (that's probably before your grandma and grandpa were born), Jesus appeared to a humble nun named Sister Faustina and told her about His Mercy. Jesus



wants everybody in the whole world, including you and me, to come to His Mercy. In one of the times that Jesus appeared to her, He told her to paint the image of Divine Mercy pouring out from His heart. In this image, Jesus is blessing the world with His one hand while His other hand is resting on the side that was wounded by the soldier's spear. We remember, boys and girls, that when the soldiers wounded Jesus on the cross with his spear, blood and water gushed out from his side. That's what the red and white rays of light that we see in the Divine Mercy image.

Jesus also told Sister Faustina to put the words, "Jesus, I trust in you", at the bottom of the Divine Mercy image to remind everyone to trust Jesus, to trust God.

Jesus wants to give very special helps or graces to everyone who comes to Him. When we come to Jesus, we come with trust in our hearts.


Jesus said many things to Sister Faustina, including the Divine Mercy Chaplet prayer.
