

About our new deacon

Deacon Mark Romeo, ordained in May 2012, serves in the Archdiocese of Toronto. He was initially assigned to "Guardian Angel's Parish" in Brampton where he assisted in the "Faith Formation Program" which included 'Alpha', 'Theology of the Body' and 'Bible study' for both adult and youth tracks.



Shortly after his ordination he was assigned as the 'Associate Liaison' for the "Catholic Charismatic Renewal" (CCRC) in the Archdiocese of Toronto. In 2014, with the loss of his job came the need to downsize which necessitated his move to their home in the Ottawa Valley. At that time, he discerned that it was wise he handed over the torch. Hence in mid-2015 he resigned from the Associate Liaison position.

Despite this move to Ottawa, he was encouraged by the Pastor of Guardian Angel's Parish to continue his assignment with the Parish in Brampton. In late 2016, with the arrival of two new grand-children, he and his wife June moved to Mississauga to assist with and enjoy these new arrivals. During this time he served at "St Mary's Star of the Sea Parish", Mississauga. and has since assisted in the formation of a couple of Prayer Groups. His Ministry of Charity at that time remained with assisting at the Homeless Shelter in Brampton, Peel Manor and the Brampton Civic hospital, however with the arrival of the pandemic, all Ministries of Charity changed and still remain derailed. Mark and June married in '77 and are proud parents of four boys (one who rests with the Lord), three awesome daughters-in-law and six wonderful grand children - who occupy a lot of their time.


Deacon Mark looks forward to his new assignment and being a part of the family of "St. John of the Cross".
