


Wow! We are now in October, guys! Would you imagine that. Seems like you just started school and now ... a month has passed.

Do you know that October is a month of the Holy Rosary? This special devotion to Mary, Queen of the Holy Rosary, was established by Pope St. Pius V on the anniversary of the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. Ask Mom and Dad, boys and girls, to check out the miraculous Battle of Lepanto and see how our Lady interceded for its victory.

St. Josemaria Escriva wrote a book titled "*Christ is Passing By*" and in that book, he said, "Because Mary is our mother, devotion to her teaches us to be authentic sons: to love truly, without limit; to be simple, without the complications which come from selfishly thinking only about ourselves; to be happy, knowing that nothing can destroy our hope."

So there, boys and, praying the Holy Rosary helps us to be happy, to be simple, and to love truly. Ask Mom and Dad to pray the Rosary—perhaps, you can make it an official family prayer. That would make Mary and Jesus happy!



- Make the Sign of the Cross and say the "Apostles' Creed"
- 2. Say the "Our Father"
- 3. Say three "Hail Marys" for Faith, Hope, and Charity
- 4. Say the "Glory Be"
- 5. Announce the First Mystery and then say the "Our Father"
- 6. Say 10 "Hail Marys" while meditating on the Mystery
- 7. Say the "Glory Be" (Optional: Say the "O My Jesus" prayer requested by Mary at Fatima)
- 8. Announce the Next Mystery; then say the "Our Father" and repeat these steps (6 through 8) as you continue through the remaining Mysteries.
- **9.** Say the closing prayers: the "Hail Holy Queen" and the Final Prayer.
- 10. Make the "Sign of the Cross"

Pope Saint John Paul II suggested the recitation of the Rosary as follows: the **JOYFUL** mysteries Monday and Saturday, the **LUMINOUS** on Thursday, the **SORROWFUL** on Tuesday and Friday, and the **GLORIOUS** on Wednesday and Sunday (with this exception; Sundays of Advent and Christmas – the **IOYFUL**; Sundays of Lent – the **SORROWFUL**).




