Here they are. During our baptism, we received the gifts of:

- 1. Wisdom
- 2. Understanding
- 3. Counsel
- 4. Fortitude
- 5. Knowledge
- 6. Piety
- 7. Fear of the Lord

Wisdom helps us not to get upset over little problems. It reminds us that people are more important than things and that God's love is more than everything else.

Understanding allows us to know what God wants. It helps us make right choices in our relationship with God and others.

Counsel guides us to choose God's path and make

choices that keeps us close to God. Through this gift, we are able to judge how best to act almost by intuition.

Fortitude gives us the strength to follow through on the actions suggested by the gift of counsel. Fortitude goes beyond what we normally think of as courage.

Knowledge is the actual ability to know God's love and truths, which guide us to make decisions out of love for God and others.

Piety is the gift of willingness to worship and serve God. It goes beyond a sense of duty. We serve and worship God out of love.

Fear of the Lord (sometimes called Wonder & Awe) is the gift by which we are given a sense of who God really is, and who we are as creatures of God. We realize how big God is and how much He loves us.

What wonderful gifts! God is the best gift giver there is! So, we thank God, boys and girls.




