


Hey, guys! How are you all doing? Do you know that there is a cross inside you? Let's see When construction workers build a brick building, they need a glue to hold the bricks together as they stack them on top of each other. This glue is called mortar.



Our body is also made up of tiny little bricks called cells, 37.2 trillion of them. That's a lot of cells! Well, we also need some kind of a glue to hold the cells together and this glue is called laminin and since every part of our body is made up of cells, laminin essentially holds our body together. You know what's interesting about laminin? It's shaped like a cross! Isn't that amazing?

Jesus was with God the Father and the Holy Spirit at creation, and "in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth ... In him all things hold together. 
Let us pray:


