The Brown Scapular

Hello Families! Part of the celebration this Saturday after the procession of our Lady of Mount Carmel is the

blessing and distribution of Our Lady of Mount Carmel's brown scapulars. Anyone who wants to receive one can have one.

How did the brown scapular started? Church tradition says that on July 16, 1251, our Lady of Mount Carmel appeared to the prior general of the Carmelites, St. Simon Stock, at the time when the Carmelites were having great difficulty.

The Blessed Virgin promised St. Simon Stock, oppressed with worries, that whoever would wear the Carmelite habit devoutly would receive the gift of final perseverance. The habit was taken to mean the scapular in particular.

The Church documents shows with clarity the nature and meaning of the Carmelite scapular.

- 1. The scapular is a Marian habit or garment. It is both a sign and pledge. A sign of belonging to Mary; a pledge of her motherly protection, not only in this life but after death.
- **2.** As a sign, it is a conventional sign signifying three elements strictly joined: <u>first</u>, belonging to a religious family particularly devoted to Mary, especially dear to Mary, the Carmelite Order; <u>second</u>, consecration to Mary, devotion to and trust in her Immaculate Heart; <u>third</u>, an incitement to become like Mary by imitating her virtues, above all her humility, chastity, and spirit of prayer.

The scapular as a sign is rich in meaning. It is a sign of Mary's quiet presence, for the scapular is a silent devotion.

There are no prayers to be said. It reminds us of the contemplative aspect of our Christian life. Contemplation is what our saints wrote so much about. Contemplation is an ever-deepening silence in loving presence to God. It is in this silence that God best speaks to us.

So, my dear families, after the procession, come and line up inside the church to receive your Our Lady of Mount Carmel scapular, okay?


