## **"INCOME TAX PREPARATION** for Eligible Individuals

Free income tax preparation for low income individuals is offered by the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP), coordinated by the Canada Revenue Agency. Contact the parish office to check eligibility and to book an appointment on Saturdays from 9 AM to 12:00 PM, during the months of March and April. Due to the current restrictions, all tax preparation will be completed by way of telephone interview with the approval of the taxpayer.
