


Faith Q & A:

Q: Is it true that the practice of speaking in tongues important?

A: It is true that in Pentecostal church groups as well as among the members of the Catholic Charismatic groups, speaking with the gift of tongues is a common feature. Normally, it arises from the spiritual experience of a person combined with his psychic disposition. But this gift does not necessarily belong to the essential character of the Church. St. Paul did not seem to appreciate it much since it does not help in the real building up of the Church (1Cor14:6-12). He would rather consider the gift of prophesy, that is an ability to proclaim the Word of God, as a more important gift since it helps the growth of the Church.




