





THE ARCHANGELS

Hi guys! Today, we're going to talk about our heavenly friends—the archangels, the original superheroes! Their names are: Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. Do you know what their names mean?



Archangel Michael's name means "Who is like God?" brings justice and strength as he guards God's people. He is the leader of all angels in God's heavenly army. He helps us fight fear and temptations. Archangel Gabriel whose name means "Strength of God" seems to

be the key messenger. He appeared to Zachariah to foretell the birth of John the Baptist. The most important message he ever delivered was to Mary when he announced that she was going to be the Mother of Jesus.
