

It started on March 25, 1872 when the workers in a printers union went on strike. They were working 12 hours every day (long hours) and they were asking for a 9-hour a day work. They held a parade in Toronto, creating awareness about their work situations. They were supported by thousands of people and even by the Prime Minister at that time, John A. Macdonald. The workers union got their request for a 9-hour workday. It also marked the beginning of the Labour Day holiday which was made official to be on every 1st Monday in September, honouring all workers and what they do for our country.

Labour Day also signals the end of summer break. Families spend time doing leisure activities together before the new school year starts.

So, boys and girls, make sure you thank Mom, Dad, and your relatives for all that they do for Canada.


