We shall be rewarded for our good deeds. Moreover, we shall also be rewarded for our repentance of the sinful deeds we had committed. Three possibilities exist. Assuming that we are in the state of God's grace, we shall either immediately enter heaven, or spend some time in purgatory to expiate the temporal punishment that may still be due for our sins. FREE INCOME TAX FILING

"INCOME TAX PREPARATION for Eligible Individuals

Free income tax preparation for low income individuals is offered by the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP), coordinated by the Canada Revenue Agency. Contact the parish office to check eligibility and to book an appointment on Saturdays from 9 AM to 12:00 PM, during the months of March and April. Tax preparations can be done in-person or by telephone interview.


