

Our Beautiful Catholic Faith

Excerpt from St. John of the Cross' Teaching on Satan's Involvement at Every Stage of Spiritual Growth

"If the soul seeks out God, much more does God seek that soul." To achieve spiritual marriage has as a contingency the absolute route and humiliation of the devil. The contemplative soul remains victorious and immune to further attacks of the Evil One. He has become formidable to his opponent and rests in the peace and joy of Christ.

The soul which has given itself totally to God, "with a certain consummation of loving union," harbors no more appetites, nor images, forms, or affections for created things. This pristine soul has been purified of everything that is not God. Its virtues have been developed to such a high degree that one cannot see daylight between them: they form an integral whole—nothing missing. This is the *bonestia* that St. Thomas speaks of in which the truly virtuous person is virtuous in everything and at all times. There is an integrity that is complete and virtue is not "lop-sided." And such a person is not moved by the flesh, the devil, nor the world's trifles.

The transformed soul has "become God by participation in as much as this is possible in this life. As a result, it receives some of God's properties, in its weakness God's strength is freed up to manifest itself, striking terror into the enemy.

After spiritually purified souls reach the state of perfect union with God through love in the "seventh mansion," the diabolic temptations are over. In this state, the soul is so favored, so strong and victorious that the devil knows he has lost the battle.

In this state, souls are transformed in God. They are divine by participation and possess Christ-like qualities. In them, the Redeemer has defeated Satan and his kingdom of darkness. Teresa and John of the Cross struggled with demons, but in the end, their victory—and God's—was complete.

Peace follows the victorious combat. The house and all its inhabitants (the senses) is in perfect order and the intellective aspect is "inundated by a river of peace." This, says St. John of the Cross, is the return to original righteousness. This soul is confirmed in grace. This is an immense joy that penetrates every fiber of one's being: a glorious delight. Within the deepest part of the soul's intimacy, a wedding feast is being celebrated and the Holy Spirit has brought all of his fruits.


