

One of Saint John's main lessons is about **trust**. During times of spiritual dryness, we might feel lost or abandoned. Yet Saint John encourages us to stay faithful in prayer, even when we don't feel God's presence. He reminds us that God may be closer than we real-

ize, working silently to purify and strengthen our souls. Another important lesson from Saint John is **detachment**. He teaches that we should let go of things that distract us from God. This does not mean rejecting the good things in life but having the freedom to put God first. In a world full of materialism and busyness, his message of simplicity can guide us to live more peacefully.

Saint John also inspires us to be **patient**. He understood that spiritual growth takes time. Just as he found light in his darkest moments, we can find hope and purpose even in difficult times. His example shows us that staying close to God brings true peace and joy, no matter what challenges we face.
