Do More

Hey, guys, we are in the Season of Lent in the Church and what a way to start it! Ashes of cross on our foreheads!

You know, boys and girls, the season of Lent is a time to prepare for Easter! For 40 days starting Ash Wednesday (not counting Sundays) we will be preparing ourselves for Easter Sunday, the day Jesus rose from the dead.

Now, how do we exactly prepare for Easter?

Well, by doing Do More! Let's play doing more of Do More, okay? Below are some examples of what we can **Do More**. See if you can think of other good things that we can add to the list to do more of.



- 1. Thanking God for all the blessings that He has given.
- 2. Talking to God about your day. Tell him about your friends, family, school, etc.
- 3. Being helpful and kind to others.
- 4. Being polite—say, "Please" and "Thank you."
- 5. Doing your school works & chores promptly.
- 6. Follow rules at home, school, & community.
- 7. Come to church regularly.
- 8. Help the poor and the needy.
- 9. Greet your family "Good morning" every day.
- 10. Pray for your family, friends, school, church, country, and the world.

The game is that you get 1 point for every Do More good things that you do every day. See if you can beat your own score. For example, if to-day you did 5 Do Mores, then tomorrow, try to make 6. If you greet a group of your classmates Good morning and there are 5 of them, then you get 5 points for greeting them. Happy greeting counts, pouty greeting don't count. Ready? Go!


