

WHEN AN ORDINARY IS EXTRAORDINARY!

Very Good? That's great! You know, this Sunday, the Church will be in its 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time. This is one of the liturgical seasons in the Church and we will be in this season until the day before Ash Wednesday. Why is it called Ordinary? Well, the word ordinary comes from the Latin word "ordinalis" which refers to a series of numbers. When it is not one of the seasons in the Church that has a big event like Lent, Ad-

vent, Christmas, or Easter, then the Sundays are just numbered so we know where we are. This year, there will be 6 Sundays in Ordinary Time before we reach Ash Wednesday which starts the season of Lent. The Sunday after Ash Wednesday will then be the 1st Sunday of Lent.

So, what's happening during Ordinary Times? It could be a lot, actually. Ordinary Time is a time for growth and learning. During Ordinary Time, the emphasis in the Mass and in Church daily prayers is on the teachings of Jesus and His life among His disciples. The Ordinary Time offers us these opportunities to grow not just in knowledge but spiritually—meaning, we grow in love and in friendship with Jesus as we practice every day what He teaches us kindness, obedience, understanding, humility, faithfulness, truthfulness, gentleness, patience, forgiving, and being merciful towards others. When we practice what Jesus teaches, we grow spiritually. We become better people—for us, and for others. And that, my dear boys and girls, is <u>NOT</u> ordinary. It <u>IS</u> extraordinary! So, have an extraordinary, ordinary season!

Let us pray, guys:

Dear God, thank you for giving us the Ordinary Season in the Church, a time for growth and learning. Bless us, Lord, and help us make this season an extraordinary season as we do every day what Jesus teaches us. We ask this through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.


