

# Our Beautiful Catholic Faith

#### FEAST OF THE HOLY TRINITY

Today's feast invites us to live in the awareness of the presence of the Triune God within us: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

The mystery of the most Holy Trinity is a basic doctrine of faith in Christianity, understandable not with our heads but with our hearts. It teaches us that there are three distinct persons in one God, sharing the same divine nature. Our mind cannot grasp this doctrine which teaches that 1+1+1=1 and not 3. But we believe in this mystery because Jesus who is God taught it clearly, the evangelists recorded it, the Fathers of the Church tried to explain it and the Councils of Nicaea and Constantinople defined it as a dogma of Christian faith.

The New Testament clearly shows this doctrine: a) The Annunciation (Luke 1: 26-38) describes how God the Father sent the angel Gabriel to Mary, to announce to her that God, the Holy Spirit, would "overshadow" her, and that God, the Son, would be made flesh in her womb. b) During the baptism of Jesus (Matthew 3: 16-17), the Holy Spirit was shown descending on Jesus in the form of a dove, while the voice of God the Father was heard from the clouds. c) The Gospel of John (Chapters 15 through 18), presents the detailed teaching of Jesus on the Persons of the Holy Trinity. d) In the preaching mission given by the risen Lord to the disciples, Jesus commanded them to baptize people "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (cf. Matthew 28:19; John 10:30).

#### Some Life Messages for us:

- 1). We need to respect ourselves and others.
- 2). We need to be aware of God as the Source of our strength and courage.
- <u>3</u>). We need to see the Trinity as the model for our Christian families
- 4) We are called to become more like the Triune God through all our relationships. We are made in God's image and likeness. Just as God is God only in a Trinitarian relationship, so we can be fully human only as one member of a relationship of three partners 'I-God-neighbor'. The self needs to be in a horizontal relationship with all other people and in a vertical relationship with God.

#### Let us pray St. Francis favorite prayer:

"Most Holy Trinity, who lives in me, I praise you, I worship you, I adore you and I love you." Let the Son lead us to the Father through the Spirit, to live with the Triune God forever and ever. Amen."




