Along the Mystical Carmelite Way

Living in Allegiance to Jesus Christ

Jesus Christ, son of the Living God, is the person at the very centre of Christian life, and therefore of Carmelite spirituality.

Jesus of Nazareth, son of God and son of Mary, true God and true Man, is our model, our Lord, our brother and our friend. He is the 'Christ' or 'Messiah', God's anointed one,



who became human to tell us the Good News that God loves us. By pondering the words and actions of Jesus that we find in the Bible, we come to know what God is like: loving, compassionate, merciful.

The Carmelite is described as one whole lives 'in allegiance to Jesus Christ', who is expected to live devotedly in Christ, and to be whole-hearted in the service of Jesus. All the great Carmelites across the centuries have been drawn to the person of Jesus, as found particularly through pondering the Scriptures, and encountered in prayer.

The journey towards deeper union with Christ is the most demanding of all, as it leads us inwards into our own hearts. Carmelites find Christ in the very depths of their being.

Even in an age sceptical of organised religion, Jesus of Nazareth continues to exert an extraordinary fascination for people, especially the young.

FAITH Q & A

0: What is advent? Why do we observe it? A: The word "Advent" is derived from the Latin word *adventus*, meaning "coming," which is a translation of the Greek word parousia. Advent is a period for devout and joyful expectation. The Advent season lasts for four Sundays leading up to Christmas. The Sundays of this season are named the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Sundays of Advent. Advent begins four Sundays before Christmas and ends on Christmas Eve. It is observed as a time of penance, prayer and renewal of life preparing ourselves for the rebirth of Jesus in our lives. The purple or violet color of advent vestments used by priests signifies seriousness, repentance, and royalty. The color rose may be used in joyful expectation, on Gaudete Sunday (Third Sunday of Advent). The Advent wreath is a ring or wheel of of evergreens decorated with four or five candles in the center. The wreath of evergreens depicts the immortality of our soul and the new, everlasting life promised to us through Christ. The four colored candles represent the four Advent weeks and the white central candle represents Jesus the light of the world.




