# Along the Mystical Carmelite Way ....

"Contemplation is primarily something we receive, not something we do. For the Carmelite, contemplation is essentially a **gift of God** which we prepare to receive through 'de-centering', making God and others, rather than ourselves, the centre of our lives and everything we do. Preparation to receive the gift of contemplation involves two key elements of Carmelite spirituality: emptying ourselves in order to receive God (vacare Deo) and

purity of heart (*puritas cordis*). This means that we seek, with the help of God, to remove 'false gods' and sinfulness from our lives so as to be open to welcome His grace and inner healing. **Contemplation** is an encounter with God which

transforms us. It is a kind of letting go. It means resting in God, beyond words, beyond thoughts, beyond activity. It is taking to heart the words of God in the psalm: 'Be still and know that I am God.'

An important emphasis in the Carmelite tradition is the need to alert people to the fact that contemplation, as God's gift, is **open to all**: it is not the preserve of monks, or friars, or nuns, or those with plenty of leisure time. It is as much **for busy people**, leading busy lives, as for anyone else.

# Our Lady of the Rosary



Saint Pius V established the feast of Our Lady of Victory to thank God for the Christian defeat of the Turks at Lepanto—a victory attributed to praying the rosary. Pope Gregory XIII changed the name to Feast of the Holy Rosary–originally celebrated on the first Sunday in October–in 1573. Pope Clement XI extended the feast to the universal Church in 1716. And in 1913, Saint

Pius X set the date for the feast that we know today of October 7.

The purpose of the rosary is to help us meditate on the great mysteries of our salvation. Pius XII called it a compendium of the gospel. The main focus is on Jesus—his birth, life, death, and resurrection. The "Our Fathers" remind us that Jesus' Father is the initiator of salvation. The "Hail Marys" remind us to join with Mary in contemplating these mysteries. They also make us aware that Mary was and is intimately joined with her Son in all the mysteries of his earthly and heavenly existence. The "Glory Bes" remind us that the purpose of all life is the glory of the Trinity.

The rosary appeals to many. It is simple. The constant repetition of words helps create an atmosphere in which to contemplate the mysteries of God. We sense that Jesus and Mary are with us in the joys and sorrows of life. We grow in hope that God will bring us to share in the glory of Jesus and Mary forever.

The Holy Rosary is prayed before the 9am weekday Mass, Monday to Saturday, and before the 7pm Wednesdays and 1st Friday Masses in our parish.

The Parish Family Ministry is also taking the pilgrim statue of Our Lady of Mount Carmel to families in our parish and praying the Holy Rosary with them.

Archbishop Leo's October Message:

### Month of the Rosary and of the Missions

... Through the Rosary the faithful receive abundant grace, as though from the very hands of the Mother of the Redeemer" (1). In addition, we are encouraged to pray for peace in the world

since "to rediscover the Rosary means to immerse oneself in contemplation of the mystery of Christ who "is our peace", since



he made "the two of us one, and broke down the dividing wall of hostility" (Eph 2:14). Consequently, one cannot recite the Rosary without feeling caught up in a clear commitment to advancing peace, especially in the land of Jesus, still so sorely afflicted and so close to the heart of every Christian" (6). Finally, the other great prayer intention always associated with the Rosary, is that for families. As the Pope stated: "A similar need for commitment and prayer arises in relation to another critical contemporary issue: the family, the primary cell of society, increasingly menaced by forces of disintegration on both the ideological and practical planes, so as to make us fear .....


