Who are the Angels?

The word angel comes from Greek word *angelos* meaning a messenger. One of the earliest traditions of the

Bible is that God used spiritual beings when he wished to communicate his message or protect someone on earth. These beings are normally shown as having wings, since their essential function was to take messages around. Already in the Book of Genesis, we notice the function of the function of the angels. An angel appears to Hagar in the desert and assures her of protection (Gen. 16:7); another angel meets Abraham and prevents the sacrifice of Isaac (Gen 24:7); yet another angel speaks to Jacob in a dream (Gen 31:11). The list continues in other books of the Bible too. The names of some angles are specifically mentioned along with their mission on behalf of God. Angel Raphael is a guide, healer, and expeller of demons (Tob 5-6). Angel Gabriel's message to Mary pertained to the incarnation of Jesus. Michael leads an angelic army to fight and defeat the dragon and his forces (Rev 12:7).


