

Along the Mystical Carmelite Way **Aspects of Carmelite Prayer:** Liturgical

For Carmelites, contemplation grows out of liturgical prayer. Foremost among the liturgical actions is the celebration of the Eucharist, as St. Albert wrote in his original Rule: "You are to gather each morning to hear Mass." Through the reception of Holy Communion, Carmelites can



"walk day and night" to the mountain of God, following in the steps of St. Elijah (1 Kings 19:4-8) who ate the heavenly bread provided by the angel.



The Liturgy of the Hours (or Divine Office) is a mini-retreat during seven-time intervals of the day. Communities of Carmelite nuns, friars, and hermits, usually gather to chant these prayers, comprised mostly of the psalms, biblical read-

ings, and intercessory prayer.


