ST. JOHN OF THE CROSS

John is a saint because his life was a heroic effort to live up to his name: "of the Cross."

Ordained a Carmelite priest in 1567 at age 25, John met Teresa of Avila and like her, vowed himself to the primitive Rule of the Carmelites. John engaged in the work of reform, and came to experience the price of reform: increasing opposition, misunderstanding, persecution, imprisonment. He came to know the cross acutely—to experience the dying of Jesus—as he sat month after month in his dark, damp, narrow cell with only his God.

Yet, the paradox! In this dying of imprisonment John came to life, uttering poetry. In the darkness of the dungeon, John's spirit came into the Light.

In his life and writings, John of the Cross has a crucial word for us today. We tend to be rich, soft, comfortable. We shrink even from words like *self-denial, mortification, purification, asceticism, discipline*. We run from the cross. John's message—like the gospel—is loud and clear: Don't—if you really want to live!

EPISCOPAL VISIT & BLESSING

Bishop Ivan Camilleri will be blessing the three new statues in our parish during his episcopal visit next weekend. He will bless the two statues in the sanctuary: Saint Joseph and the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the statue of Saint John of the Cross in the rotunda.

Plenary Indulgence for the Jubilee Year of Saint John of the Cross

On 6 October 2025, the Apostolic Penitentiary published a decree granting a plenary indulgence on the occasion of the Sanjuanist Centenaries, which will be celebrated from 14 December 2025 to 27 December 2026, during which the third centenary of the canonization and the first centenary of the ecclesiastical Doctorate of Saint John of the Cross will be celebrated. The decree specifies that the faithful will be able to benefit from the indulgence, under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father), if they participate in a spirit of penance and devotion in the jubilee celebrations or if they go on pilgrimage to the designated churches.

St. John of the Cross, our parish patron saint, pray for us and our families.


