#### **Adoration Chapel Terminologies:**

WATCHER— someone who signs up to commit to stay with the Blessed Sacrament for silent prayer on the same day and at the same time every week. They sign up for a 1 - hour time slot, i.e., every 2pm on Mondays.

VISITOR—anyone who cannot commit to be a watcher but comes to the chapel to visit the Blessed Sacrament at anytime of the week and stay as long as they can.



This is an analogy of the human heart. Its purpose is to pour out love for others. If our hearts are impure, then what we 'pour our' to others will be infected. But there is no point is having a pure heart simply to leave it empty; the point of purity is not an end in itself but a means to be useful for others.

This is what Carmelites mean by purity: having a heart undivided for God, free from our own motives and desires so that God's will be done in us.



Maria Purissima, Mary Most Pure, is the great example of purity, in that her heart is totally given over to God and pours out love towards those around her.


