A dear friend of mine, Carmelite priest Fr. Jack Welch, once spoke to me about the reality of being alone. We were on retreat at the beautiful Benedictine monastery, St. Bernard Abbey in Alabama. He was the retreat master, and I was his ride to the airport and a retreat participant. One afternoon between talks, we took a walk together around the monastery grounds. Our conversation covered the customary topics of sports, politics, and faith. I was discerning a possible new chapter in my life and

struggling to find a clear path forward. It was obvious that following God's will meant completely following Jesus, without fear and hesitation. I had committed to this path many years earlier, but now I was feeling "alone" and fearful. Fr. Jack said very simply. "No



matter where you find yourself next, God is always, already there." We are never really alone, as God's hand is outstretched to welcome us and guide us. In his first remarks to the 1.4 billion Catholics across the world, Pope Leo was saying reach out, take a hand...a neighbor, a friend, a stranger...and trust that God is already there. **¡Adelante!** Although these were the first remarks of our new Pope, I sincerely believe that words matter. He was very careful to encourage us, and to remind us that we are not alone, and that we need God and each other to face this journey. Notice at the end of the quote, Pope Leo offered a little nudge to us who might be wondering what is next. He said, "let us move forward." Forward is the only direction when walking in faith.


