

Along the Mystical Carmelite Way Aspects of Carmelite Prayer: The Humanity of Jesus

If prayer is a love relationship, then it follows that one must *know* God first in order to love Him. After all, who can love what he does not know? But there's a problem—according to apophatic theology, God is unknowable—his essence is utterly transcendent and beyond human concepts. Fortunately, God Himself solves this problem by stepping into time and offering the means to know Him through his Son, Jesus Christ: "No one knows who the Father is except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him" (Luke 10:22). Jesus becomes our gateway to know the Father.

St. Teresa of Avila discovered that by remaining close to the humanity of Jesus, she understood hidden mysteries: I clearly see that if we expect to please him and receive an abundance of his graces, God desires that these graces must come to us from the hands of Christ, through his most sacred humanity, in which God takes delight. Many, many times I have perceived this through experience. The Lord has told it to me. I have definitely seen that we must enter by this gate if we wish his Sovereign Majesty to reveal to us great and hidden mysteries. (Life 22:6)

While it may be said that St. John of the Cross is chief among apophatic theologians, yet in practice, he remained ever close to the humanity of Christ. For him, Jesus is not only the gateway to the spiritual journey (Ascent, Bk. 2:7:2) but also its completion: One of the main reasons for the desire to be dissolved and

One of the main reasons for the desire to be dissolved and be with Christ is to see Him face to face and thoroughly understand the mysteries of the Incarnation, which is by no means the lesser part of beatitude (SC Stanza 37:1).

For Eligible Individuals

Free income tax preparation for low income individuals is offered by the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP), coordinated by the Canada Revenue Agency. Tax preparations can be done in-person or by telephone interview. The accountant will call you to confirm your appointment.


