# Aspects of Carmelite Prayer: Prayer Requires Stillness

If Carmelites seek the desert atmosphere, it is simply to achieve stillness of soul—the requisite disposition for prayer. St. Teresa Benedicta (1891-1942) explains, "The work of salvation takes place in obscurity and stillness."

Yet, stillness is difficult to attain because it requires not only freedom from external noise but more especially, interior agitation. Unchecked passions, emotions, and anxiety wreak havoc on stillness. As Catherine de Houck Doherty says in her classic book, *Poustinia*, "Where noise is—inward noise and confusion—there God is not." Hence, there is a great need to set aside worry as it destroys the ability to pray. Elder Thaddeus Vitovnica (1914-2003) recommends seeking freedom from care;

Prayer requires a completely carefree life, for even the slightest worry disrupts our prayer...Just as a speck of dust can blur our vision, so too, does the slightest worry interfere with our concentration in prayer. When we are united with the Lord, then our soul is at peace and Grace descends upon us.

To arrive at this stillness, one must then quiet the interior, including stray thoughts, worries, emotions, and desires. The Dijon Carmelite, St. Elizabeth of the Trinity (1880-1906) says, "My Rule tells me:

'In silence will your strength be.' It seems to me, therefore, that to keep one's strength for the Lord is to unify one's whole being by means of interior silence, to collect all one's powers in order to employ them in the one work of love."

# For Eligible Individuals

Free income tax preparation for low income individuals is offered by the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP), coordinated by the Canada Revenue Agency. Contact the parish office to check eligibility and to book an appointment on Saturdays from 9 AM to 12:00 PM, during the months of March and April. Each appointment will be about 30 minutes.

Tax preparations can be done in-person or by telephone interview. Let the accountant know when they call you to confirm your schedule.


