

Along the Mystical Carmelite Way Aspects of Carmelite Prayer: Prayer is Breathing God's Breath

It is said in the *Book of Genesis* that Adam became a living being after God breathed the breath of life into his nostrils. In like manner, prayer opens the soul's nostrils, as it were, in order to inhale the breath of the Holy Spirit. This "inspiration," causes the soul to become a living being. "It is the Spirit that gives life," says Jesus (Jn 6:63).


The word "spirit" in many languages, such as Hebrew (ruah) and Greek (pneuma), also means breath. In prayer, therefore, God's breath unites with our breath and impels the soul upwards and onwards. As the French Carmelite Brother Lawrence of the Resurrection (1614-1691), puts it, "Those who are empowered by the breath of the Holy Spirit sail along even when asleep."

St. Elijah experienced this breath as a gentle whisper while dwelling on Mt. Horeb: "After the fire, there was the sound of a gentle whisper. When Elijah heard it, he wrapped his face in his mantle and went out and stood at



the entrance of the cave" (1 Kgs 19:12-13). St. John of the Cross describes the divine breeze of the Holy Spirit as the 'south wind.' He says that God breathes through the garden of the soul with the south wind in order

to infuse gifts and awaken love (Sp. C. Stanza 17:4-9). Elsewhere, St. John of the Cross describes the breathing of the Holy Spirit as a "spiration."

LENTEN OBSERVANCES WE CAN DO

- **1)** <u>Holy Mass</u>: Making more frequent participation in the Holy Mass during the week is an excellent Lenten observance because the Eucharistic celebration is the most sublime of Christian prayers.
- **2)** <u>Lectio Divina</u>: It is the practice of slow, prayerful, meditative reading of the selected passages of the Sacred Scripture.
- 3) **Fasting and abstinence**: Fasting is taking only one major meal per day and abstinence is avoiding meat.
- 4) <u>Decide on Lenten Sacrifices</u> appropriate to the age of each child in the family, reminding them that our souls need this spiritual exercise to gain strength for living as Christians, just as our bodies need exercise to remain healthy.
- 5) <u>Acts of Charity</u>: Find out someone in need of our prayer, help, support or encouragement in our neighborhood and do with utmost sincerity what we can.
- 6) <u>Sacrament of Reconciliation:</u> Lent is a time for the Sacrament of Reconciliation so that we may put things right with God and others.

FREE INCOME TAX PREPARATION

For Eligible Individuals

Free income tax preparation for low income individuals is offered by the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP), coordinated by the Canada Revenue Agency. Contact the parish office to check eligibility and to book an appointment on Saturdays from 9 AM to 12:00 PM, during the months of March and April. Each appointment will be about 30 minutes.

Tax preparations can be done in-person or by telephone interview. Let the accountant know when they call you to confirm your schedule.


