

Along the Mystical Carmelite Way Aspects of Carmelite Prayer:

Awareness of the Presence of God

Following the example of St. Elijah, the goal of Carmelite prayer is to live always with God. *The Lord of Hosts lives*, said Elijah, *before whose face I stand* (I Kings 18:5). The Catalonian Carmelite, Fr. Bartolomé Xiberta (1897-1967) explains:

The highest aspiration of Carmel during this earthly life is to anticipate insofar as this is possible the presence of God, which in heaven will be given on a perfect level. Evidently, all our efforts should follow as a result of the divine presence.

To cultivate this awareness, one must exercise faith in Him who is present everywhere and who sees and hears everything. Plugging into this awareness not only activates divine intimacy but also nips temptation in the bud. St. Teresa reminds her sisters that "The Lord walks among the pots and pans" (Life 5.8). Such awareness turns the most mundane actions into gold.

The French Carmelite, Br. Lawrence of the Resurrection, was a humble lay-brother assigned to kitchen work. He developed such a facility in communing with God during work that it didn't matter to him if he had to scrub



dishes or was in the chapel on his knees. He found God everywhere. He composed a treatise on this subject which is now a classic, *The Practice of the Presence of God*. He says,

We do not have to be in church to be with God. We can make of our hearts an oratory where we can withdraw from time to time to converse with him, gently, humbly, and lovingly. Everyone is capable of these familiar conversations with God, some more, some less...

Listen — and Respond — like Mary at the Annunciation. Mary has been called the "mother of listening." She didn't just hear the Word; she pondered it in light of her own relationships and circumstances and then let it transform her.
