

Along the Mystical Carmelite Way Aspects of Carmelite Prayer:

Aspiration & Aspirative Prayer



An effective means of practicing the presence of God is through the use of aspirations and aspirative prayer. The word aspiration comes from the Latin verb *aspirare* which means 'breathing towards.' The use of aspirations helps one to remain connected with God out-

side of formal times of prayer, such as during work or rest. While these terms appear related (aspire=breath), they are distinct.

Aspirations are brief prayers that are as gentle as breath. Aspirative prayer, on the other hand, is more like a fiery dart or arrow of love that is shot toward God. It involves a greater upward thrust and movement of the will. The noted authority on this form of prayer is the French Carmelite, Venerable John of St. Samson (1571-1636). He describes aspirative prayer in these terms:

"It is a loving and inflamed thrust of the whole heart and the entire spirit by which the soul goes beyond itself and transcends every created being, becoming closely united to God in the brilliance of the manifestation of love."

The flame of love, suggests Ven. John grows through the practice of aspirations: It is so excellent that by means of it, you will shortly reach the summit of perfection and you will be aflame with the love of Love itself.

Faith Q & A:

When is an act morally good?

An act is morally good when it assumes simultaneously the goodness of the object, of the end, and of the circumstances. A chosen object can by itself vitiate an act in its entirety, even if the intention is good. It is not licit to do evil so that good may result from it. An evil end corrupts the action, even if the object is good in itself. On the other hand, a good end does not make an act good if the object of that act is evil, since the end does not justify the means. Circumstances can increase or diminish the responsibility of the one who is acting but they cannot change the moral quality of the acts themselves. They never make good an act which is in itself evil. (CCC 1755-1756, 1759-1760)


