Along the Mystical Carmelite Way **Aspects of Carmelite Praver:**

Prayer is Nourished by the Word of God

The Rule of Carmel is rich with scriptural inferences. The author, St. Albert, exhorts the brethren on Mt. Carmel to meditate frequently on Scripture: Each one must remain in his cell or near it, meditating on the Law of the Lord day and night and keeping vigil in prayer. St. Albert indicates that the Word of God is part of the spiritual armor: *Let the* sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, dwell abundantly in your mouth and in your hearts, and whatever you do, let it done in the word of the Lord. Hence, Carmelites



have long cultivated a deep love for Scripture. Carmelite reformer, Blessed John Soreth, compares meditation upon Scripture to hearing the voice of the Son of God as He awakens the dead (cf. In. 5:25):

When it sounds in the soul's ears, the divine voice disturbs, frightens, judges, gives life, loosens, enlightens, and cleanses; the Word of God is our food, a sword, our strengthening, our medicine, our repose, our consummation.

The frequent meditation of Scripture not only sustains the life of virtue but also is essential fuel for prayer. Without this meditation, love grows cold: "For lack of wood, the fire goes out" (Pr. 26:20).

God gives a trace of his Being through the Holy Scriptures. St. Thérèse says,

Since Jesus has gone to Heaven, I can follow Him only by the traces He has left. But how radiant and how fragrant these traces are! I have only to glance at the Holy Gospels, and at once I breathe the fragrance of His life and know which way to run.
