PRAYER FOR THE CONCLAVE

Lord Jesus Christ, by entrusting to St. Peter and his successors the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven, thou didst establish the office of the papacy. Grant to thy Church, we beseech thee, a pope who, in his dedication to the Sacred Tradition of the Church, will seek to govern the Church according to the Deposit of Faith and for the salvation of souls. Immaculate Mary, Mother of the Church and Queen of Confessors, we consecrate to thee the conclave and the election of the Holy Father. Blessed Mother, look not upon our sinfulness or upon the infidelity of many Catholics who do not accept the teaching of thy Son, but upon the Church which is the spotless Bride of thy son, so that we do not get the leader we deserve, but a Holy Father who will guide the Church for the glory and honor of thy Son. Amen.

Along the Mystical Carmelite Way Aspects of Carmelite Prayer: Intercession

The Mystical Body of Christ is the original networking system. Bodies may be separated by continents but souls are connected through prayer. Hence, intercession on behalf of others is at the heart of Carmelite prayer. It has its roots in the example of Elijah, whose prayer restored the widow of Zaraphath's son from death (1 Kings 17:21-22) and who obtained rain from heaven after a three-year drought (1 Kgs 18-19). Intercessory prayer has been a key factor throughout Carmelite history. Its effectiveness may be seen in the example of St. Therese of Lisieux (1873-1897). Though hidden in solitude, her gift of prayer and suffering reached souls on distant continents. She describes her concept of intercession as love in the heart of the Church:

I understood that if the Church has a body composed of different members, the noblest and most necessary of all the members would not be lacking to her. I understood that the Church has a heart and that this heart burns with Love. I understood that Love alone makes its members act, that if this Love were to be extinguished, the Apostles



would no longer preach the Gospel, and the Martyrs would refuse to shed their blood...Jesus, my love, at last I have found my vocation. My vocation is love. In the heart of the Church, my mother, I will be love,

and then I will be all things. (Story of a Soul)

Significantly, thirty years after her death, Pope Pius XI proclaimed St. Therese as Patron of Missions. How could this cloistered Carmelite, who never left her monastery, be on equal footing with the great missionary St. Francis Xavier? It is because the ardor of her love spread through all the veins of the Mystical Body.


